

## NEW FLASHBANG ALTERNATIVE FOR SWAT

Flashbangs (AKA stun grenades or flash grenades) have been in use by law enforcement and military for the past 50 years. They are remarkably effective at disorienting and providing police and special operations with a tactical advantage. While they are considered non-lethal devices, there have been cases where people are injured or fires are started as a result of improper use of flashbangs.

The TEDD (tactical electronic distraction device) was created as a flashbang alternative (not a replacement). The TEDD, equipped with the combination of blinding light and 120db of loud noise, serves as an effective distraction device for use in trainings along with high risk / threat calls.

Because there is no explosive or concussive effect with the TEDD, it will not cause fires if it makes contact with curtains or spread narcotics in a room. There is also no way that it will cause any burning of the skin or trauma.

The TEDD has 8 programmable light and sound modes. It can function as light only, sound only or both. It is also equipped with 4 programmable activation delays for use with different training scenarios or call types.

These smart features and safe design make the TEDD an effective distraction device for use in:

- Law enforcement trainings
- Known drug houses
- Small spaces
- Vans, RVs, buses or train / rail cars
- Known drug houses / locales
- Places with very young or elderly persons or small animals
- Riots
- Special events

The TEDD is rechargeable and reusable. Made of steel, nylon and polycarbonate, it is built to withstand impact and is capable of breaking through glass and windows.

Depending on your department or local / state / country protocols, no documentation, paperwork or permission is needed when a TEDD is deployed.
